

Pengembangan Berkelanjutan Masyarakat Agromaritim untuk Mencapai *Socio-Resilience* melalui Pengabdian Mahasiswa

(Sustainable Development of Agromaritime Communities to Achieve Socio-Resilience through Student Service)

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ABSTRAK

Kuliah Kerja Nyata Tematik (KKNT) Inovasi merupakan suatu bentuk pendidikan dengan cara memberikan pengalaman belajar kepada mahasiswa untuk hidup di tengah masyarakat di luar kampus. Mahasiswa dibimbing oleh dosen bersama masyarakat melaksanakan program pengembangan potensi di desa/kelompok masyarakat/kelompok usaha masyarakat. Tujuan kegiatan ini yaitu : 1) Mahasiswa yang dibimbing oleh dosen mampu memecahkan masalah kompleks melalui kerjasama tim lintas disiplin/keilmuan/transdisiplin melalui kegiatan pengembangan masyarakat, 2) Mahasiswa yang dibimbing oleh dosen mampu merencanakan, melaksanakan, dan mengevaluasi kegiatan pengembangan masyarakat di desa/lokasi KKNT Inovasi. Kegiatan ini meliputi beberapa tahap yaitu : 1) Penerimaan oleh pemerintah daerah, 2) Lokakarya 1 untuk memaparkan rencana program kerja, 3) Supervisi untuk mengevaluasi program kerja, 4) Lokakarya 2 untuk memaparkan hasil kegiatan. Kegiatan KKNT Inovasi telah dilaksanakan pada tanggal 24 Juni – 5 Agustus 2024, diikuti oleh 3.746 mahasiswa dan 200 Dosen. Sebanyak 10 provinsi, 44 kabupaten/kota, dan 415 desa menjadi lokasi kegiatan. Selain itu, terdapat tim yang melakukan kegiatan di Malaysia dan Thailand. Sebanyak 396 luaran wajib telah dihasilkan seperti laporan akhir, draft jurnal pengabdian, profil pengabdian, dan dokumentasi kegiatan. Luaran lain juga dihasilkan seperti poster sebanyak 295 karya, peta potensi wilayah sebanyak 161 karya, buku tepat guna sebanyak 93 karya, dan sertifikasi produk sebanyak 17 karya. Pengabdian mahasiswa melalui kegiatan ini telah memberikan dampak nyata dalam pengembangan desa-desa di dalam dan luar negeri. Dengan dukungan dari akademisi, pemerintah daerah, dan masyarakat, program ini berpeluang menjadi model inovasi pembangunan desa yang berkelanjutan.

ABSTRACT

Thematic Community Service Lecture (KKNT) Innovation is a form of education by providing students with learning experiences to live in the community outside the campus. Students are guided by lecturers together with the community to carry out potential development programs in villages/community groups/community business groups. The objectives of this activity are: 1) Students who are guided by lecturers are able to solve complex problems through cross-disciplinary/scientific/transdisciplinary teamwork through community development activities, 2) Students who are guided by lecturers are able to plan, implement, and evaluate community development activities in villages/KKNT Innovation locations. This activity includes several stages, namely: 1) Acceptance by the local government, 2) Workshop 1 to present the work program plan, 3) Supervision to evaluate the work program, 4) Workshop 2 to present the results of the activity. The KKNT Innovation activity was carried out on June 24 - August 5, 2024, attended by 3,746 students and 200 lecturers. A total of 10 provinces, 44 districts/cities, and 415 villages became the locations of the activity. In addition, there are teams that carry out activities in Malaysia and Thailand. A total of 396 mandatory outputs have been produced such as final reports, draft community service journals, community service profiles, and activity documentation. Other outputs have also been produced such as 295 posters, 161 regional potential maps, 93 appropriate books, and 17 product certifications. Student service through this activity has had a real impact on the development of villages at home and abroad. With support from academics, local governments, and the community, this program has the potential to become a model for sustainable village development innovation.
